

STANDARD PRICING SCHEDULE: ML
Municipal Lighting

STATE OF OKLAHOMA

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available under written contract to municipalities for the purpose of lighting highways, streets, and other areas where the Cooperative may lawfully serve. The Cooperative will provide maintenance and energy to existing and future, municipality-owned lighting systems. The Cooperative may elect to not serve a lighting system, new or existing, if it is found to be unsafe, uneconomical to maintain, or not in keeping with good engineering practices. An Agreement for Service will be required to be eligible for this tariff.

RATES

The monthly prices for mercury vapor or Lumen equivalent lighting are shown below.

<u>Size and Description</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>	<u>Monthly kWh for PCA</u>
175 Watt or -7,000 Lumens equivalent	\$4.20	70
400 Watt or -20,000 Lumens equivalent	\$10.25	160

The Cooperative may permit municipal customers at their cost to have obsolete lamps replaced with approved lamps having equivalent lumen.

SPECIAL OR NON-STANDARD FACILITIES

If the municipality requests the Cooperative to serve non-standard facilities and there are no engineering, construction, safety, legal, or practical reasons which would, in the Cooperative's judgment, make such service inadvisable, the Cooperative will serve the non-standard lighting system.
